



The Parliamentary Launch of The 2008 ITSPA Awards – Saluting the best in the VoIP and Unified Communications Sectors

The Internet Telephony Services Providers' Association (ITSPA) has launched a search for the UK's top performers in the UK Internet Telephony market. The Awards will take place in the Members Room at the House of Commons on December 11th from 4pm-6pm hosted by Derek Wyatt MP.

The 2008 ITSPA Awards will reward the industry's top players after a panel of judges complete a rigorous analysis of their offered products and services.
